


Key presidential swing states



Key transition events

Pre-election “planning” phase

- Name transition chair(s) and key staff
- Develop relationships with the GSA, FBI, OPM, OGE, current administration, and Congress
- Set goals and develop project plan for transition


Post-election “transition phase”

- Appointing key White House and agency staff
- Deploy teams to agencies for policy/structure review
- Finalizing policy agenda/schedule
- Naming cabinet

Post-inauguration “handover” phase

- New admins must fill about 4,000 political positions
- Over 1,200 positions require Senate confirmation
- Official transition organization must also wind down



BIOGRAPHY

A stalwart of the Democratic Party for nearly a half-century, Biden's stances have evolved while his style, approach and ambition to be President have stayed constant

- Elected to the Senate at age 29 and made his presidential ambitions known early in his career; ran unsuccessfully in 1988 and 2008
- Led the Judiciary and Foreign Relations Committees during his Senate tenure, developing a reputation for bipartisanship
- Selected as a running mate by Barack Obama for his retail politics skills, strength with working class voters, and foreign policy clout
- As VP, led oversight of 2009 stimulus package and a gun control task force, while advocating for a restrained U.S. Afghanistan policy
- Positioned himself as the candidate of stability and experience in the 2020 Democratic primary
- Since becoming the presumptive nominee, Biden has prioritized finding common ground with progressives and rhetorically embracing their calls for systemic change, while maintaining his core moderate proposals
- Cadre of top advisors with deep ties to the Clinton and Obama Administrations reflect Biden's center-left policy preferences






117th Congress makeup




117th US Senate makeup


2020 US House results


2020 US House results

2020 governor and state legislature results






2020 governor results


2021 governor makeup

2021 state legislature makeup








Marijuana legalization ballot initiatives
